Scout Introduces New 277 LXF

Summerville, SC – Scout Boats, Inc. has unveiled the new 277 LXF, which replaces the popular 275 LXF in the model lineup.

Scout's LXF Collection is comprised of luxury sportfish models that showcase a unique blending of high-performance fish boats with high-end cruisers. The cross between these two popular recreational marine mainstays allows one to enjoy amenities on this collection normally only found on much larger sportfishers.

"We took a hard look at our popular 275 LXF model, one of the first models that initiated our LXF lineup years ago," said Scout CEO/Founder Steve Potts. "Replacing this model with something that would be even more popular than the original meant taking what was already proven and building upon it with enhancements and refinements. That's how we designed our new 277."

The 277 LXF has numerous standard features including a port side swing-in door; starboard under gunnel rod storage; port aft recirculating baitwell; stainless steel flush mount rod holders; port and starboard in floor fish boxes with diaphragm pump; large cockpit fishing area; integrated stern seat; LED cockpit courtesy rope lighting; forward seating with storage underneath and removable forward seating backrests; a powder coated T-top hardtop with an integrated frameless windshield and rocket launchers; deluxe fiberglass leaning post with companion seats with cushions that fold into bolsters; a Garmin 942 XS display with B60 transducer; hydraulic steering with tilt; trim tabs; Fusion Bluetooth stereo with four 7.7" JL Audio speakers; and a completely private, self-contained head with locking door, just to name a few. The model also has transom door that leads way to a fully-walkable swim platform, and the bow seating has been widened as well for added comfort.

Ready for any fishing, watersports or entertainment adventure you want to embark on, the 277 also boasts notable optional features such as upgraded leaning post options; upgraded Garmin screen options; your choice of four upholstery cushion color upgrades; Lumishore underwater lights; outriggers; 12V refrigerator; teak on the swim platforms; removable teak bow table; and a ski pylon.

Scout builds luxury sportfishing center console, dual console and inshore/bay boat models ranging from 17' to 53'. Since its founding three decades ago, the company's goal has been to manufacture the best-built boats in its distinctive sportfishing niches.
